

Pet Training

It's never too late to start training your family dog! In this six-class session you and your dog will learn all the things that a "good dog" needs to know to be a calm, productive family member, including:

- Walking on leash
- Sitting and lying down when told
- Greeting humans and other dogs
- Good grooming behaviors, and
- Learning to come when called.

Completion of this session gives you and your dog the tools to participate in the AKC Canine Good Citizen Test.

No matter what size or age the dog, they will benefit from this basic obedience training so they may move up to other activities such as Advanced Obedience, Rally or Agility.

Rally

Rally is a combination of obedience and agility. Performing obedience routines on an agility type course.

You are encouraged to talk to your dog and urge them on to have lots of fun in an AKC titling event.

TOTC instructors will teach you and your dog how to compete with the best in Rally Obedience!

Classes require the discipline to train your dog every day during the session.

These classes are not designed for children under 13 years of age.

Bring your dog and vaccination records (not just a tag) to the first class proving, DHP-Parvo and Rabies protection.

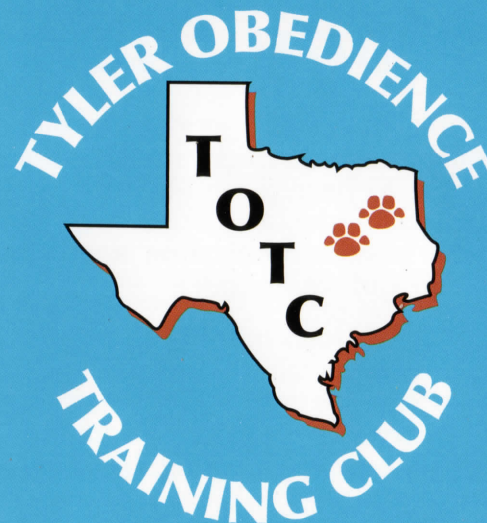
Whether your dog needs behavior, obedience or activity training, Tyler Obedience Training Club has the knowledge to put you and your dog on the road to success!

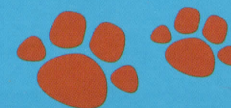

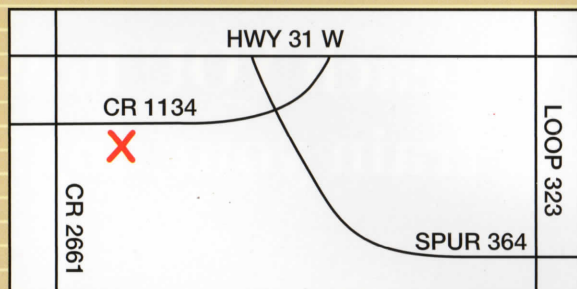
Puppy Class

Teaching your puppy good manners is not as difficult as you might think! We teach you how to have a well-behaved puppy using very basic obedience with lots of activity, positive motivation and fun for both you and your pup.

Your 8-week to 4-month-old puppy will learn how to socialize with other pups and how to sit, stay and come when called. This 6-week session also emphasizes responsible care, grooming, handling and house training.

Completion of the class will qualify your pup to be an AKC S.T.A.R. Puppy

Afterwards, we recommend moving up to the Pet Training Session where you will learn even more about how to have a calm, friendly and productive member of the family.

Agility

Basic Obedience and control of your dog is a prerequisite for Agility.

Beginner & Novice Classes

We start you and your dog off by safely introducing the obstacles, teaching handlers and dogs to work together as a team and teaching you how to run short sequences of obstacles.

Intermediate

For dogs and handlers that have completed one or more beginner sessions. We improve your timing and skills on all obstacles. Handlers learn how to guide their dogs from a distance and position themselves for best performance.

Advanced

For handlers and dogs that are ready to compete in trials. We develop in you the skills enabling dog and handler to move through the courses with greater speed and accuracy.

Advanced Obedience

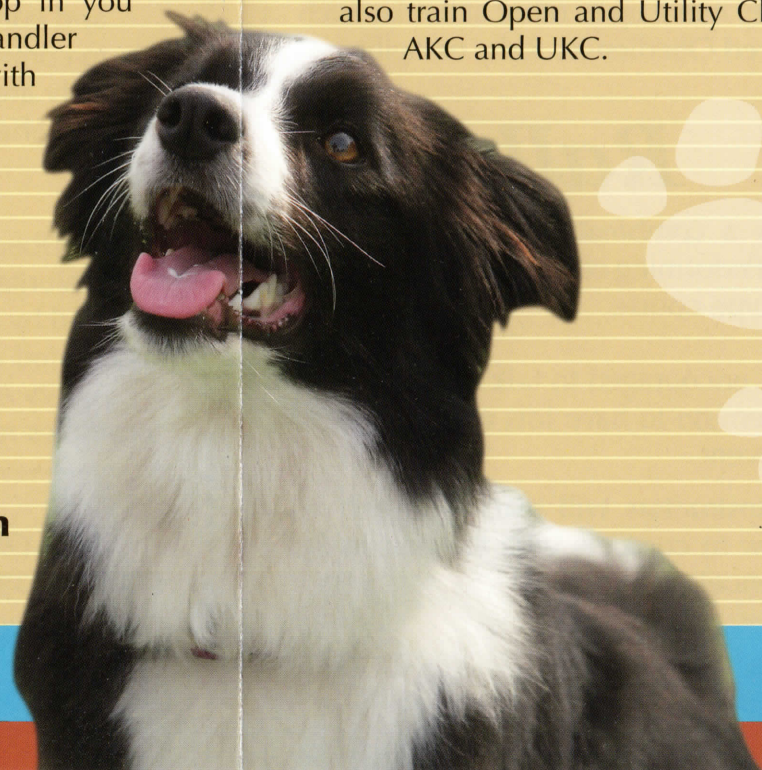
Invest in training your dog!
